Drop-off stations are free to Fort Worth residents.

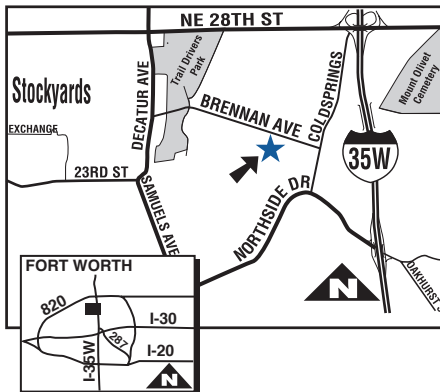
- Proof of residency (current water bill or drivers license) is required.
- Size and volume limitations will apply.
- Residents must off-load to containers themselves.
- Commercial waste will not be accepted (no dual-axle trailers or business vehicles).
- Apartment residents may drop off recyclables only.
- All incoming loads must be tarped, secured or covered.

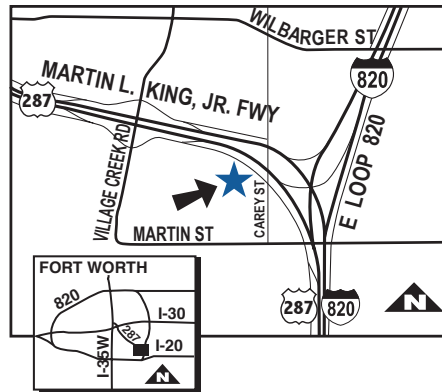
## Drop-Off Station #1

### ✓ CAN be dropped off

- Appliances (with/without coolant)
- Bagged household garbage
- Brush, leaves, yard trimmings
- Bulky items (furniture, lumber, carpet)
- Computers & electronics
- Recyclable items
- Tires (limit of 4)

### ✗ CANNOT be dropped off

- Concrete, rock, dirt, ceramic tile
- Roofing materials
- Explosives or ammunition
- Butane or propane tanks

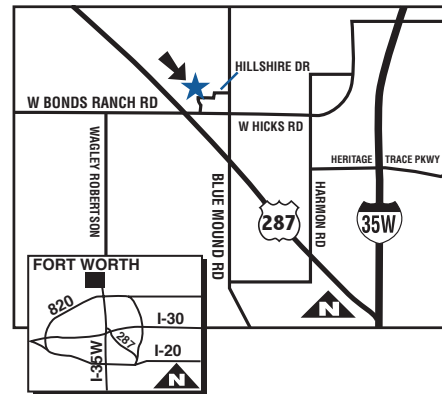
