Tips for a Safe Cleanup

Whether it is a KFWB hosted event or your own volunteer-led cleanup, be sure to use these helpful tips to ensure a safe cleanup.

- Select a location away from heavy traffic.
- Stay out of the street and roadways.
- Always wear gloves.
- Wear appropriate clothing: high-top work boots, long pants, long sleeves, work gloves, a hat, sunscreen and insect repellent.
- Have enough adults to properly supervise youth volunteers.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Do not pick up broken glass, syringes or other items that may cut or puncture the skin.
- Do not attempt to clean up unknown waste materials that you believe are hazardous.
- Beware of stepping on, or standing in, ant mounds.
- Have a first aid kit available.
- When finished, count your volunteers, number of hours worked and number of bags collected.
- Do not abandon bags on any property. Take all bagged trash and recyclables to the nearest Drop-Off Station. Leaving bags next to a trash can in a city park is also acceptable.
