### Working Group Recommendations

#### Duties

FORT WORTH<sub>®</sub>

- Gather, evaluate and discuss information relative to recommending changes to policies and procedures or confirming that specific policies and procedures are acceptable
- Identify policing issues suitable for further review as requested

#### Board Members

- Up to 15 Board Members
- Fort Worth residents
- Must have experience with a diverse community perspective
- Must have training, including ride-ins with officers
- No consensus on felony convictions

### What we heard at the October 18, 2022 Council Work Session

FORT WORTH<sub>®</sub>

- Board size 9 members (increasing to 11 members after 2023 election), each councilmember to appoint 1 member
- Prohibit individuals with felony convictions from serving on the Board
- Clarify that individuals had to <u>complete training</u> before being allowed to serve on the Board



FORT WORTH<sub>®</sub>

- Whether a Community Board should be created
- If created, whether a Community Board should:
  - Be allowed to receive complaints
  - Be allowed to review and make recommendations on certain investigations
