

MIDFIELD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT








On February 17th, 2015, Mayor and Council Communication (M&C G-18420), the City Council adopted Resolution No. 4411-02-2015 supporting the closure and redevelopment of Runway 9/27 at the Airport.

In 2018, the Texas Department of Transportation Aviation Division (TxDOT) advised the Aviation Department that funding was available to begin design and construction of the Midfield Redevelopment Project at Fort Worth Meacham International Airport (Airport).

This project closed and removed Runway 9/27 corridor so as to redevelop the area in accordance with the Airport's 2004 Master Plan and Airport Layout Plan. The redevelopment of the midfield area:

- Creates new taxiways and hanger development opportunities
- Provides increased economic viability for the Airport through lease revenue and fuel flowage fees.

- M&C C-28708 (Approved) Authorized Execution of an Engineering Services Agreement with Garver LLC, in the Amount of \$203,600.00 for the Design and Construction Management Services of the Midfield Redevelopment Improvements – Access Road and Utility Corridor Project at Fort Worth Meacham International Airport, and Adopt Appropriation Ordinance



- MC 21-0348 Authorize the Execution of an Engineering Services Agreement with Garver, LLC in the Amount of \$181,949.00 for Construction Management Services for Stage II of the Midfield Stage II Project at Fort Worth Meacham International Airport
- Total Project Cost for Aviation \$3,881,594.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PARCEL 4C AND 10C OF MIDFIELD DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

January 8 – February 8, 2019	Public Solicitation period for 4C - Results in 2 bids: <u>Cornerstone</u> (for multiple parcels) and <u>Western</u>
January 16 – March 11, 2019 -	Public Solicitation period for 10C - Resulted in 2 bids: <u>Cornerstone</u> (for multiple parcels) and <u>Western</u>
June 7 – 12, 2019	The Aviation Department to pursue Project Redwood (Gulfstream).
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REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR ALL PARCELS

Nov. 1, 2019 – Feb. 3, 2020	Public Solicitation period for AVI-112019 - Results in 3 bids: <u>Cornerstone</u> (Million Air), American Aero and <u>Texas Jet</u> (for multiple parcels).
February 10, 2020	Selection Panel - Selection Panel meets to use scoring matrix to choose proposals to submit to Aviation Advisory Board. Erik Brown, J. Law, Chris Strayer, Robert Sturns, Bill Welstead, Aaron Barth, Barbara Goodwin
June 10, 2020	Trimec Aviation submits a proposal for 7C – 8C.
September 17, 2020	Aviation Advisory Board votes to recommend <u>Texas Jet 3C – 6C</u> , <u>Trimec</u> <u>Aviation 7C– 8C</u> , and <u>American Aero 9C – 13C</u> , pending completion of construction for infrastructure.
