#### 2. Overview of GDRC Agenda. Full Transcription of the recorded meeting is below:

We will begin our Gas Drilling Review Committee for January; we have one item on the agenda today.

The Gas Drilling Review Committee role with transportation routes is just to make recommendations on the acceptability of the proposed route.

The first item on the agenda is the Fossil Hill Transportation Route.

#### **XTO ENERGY – BEECHWOOD PAD E**

Bob Manthei, with XTO Energy Corporation, presented the transportation route to the Beechwood E pad site. Trent Menning, Bucee's representative, objected the route; after further discussion, the committee agreed that the best route for XTO to use was Off Hwy 114 head south on Championship road for approximately .4 miles then head east onto outlet road for approximately .4 miles and then turn right to the Beechwood pad site entrance.

Bob Manthei, with XTO Energy Corporation, presented the transportation route to the Langley Site proposed by the developer. The committee had more questions concerning the route, and they also wanted to review the plat. This case will be continued next month.

#### EagleRidge – Mint Creek

Chris Hamilton with Peloton Land presented two routes for the Mint Creek Site; one temporary to use during construction and a proposed permanent to be used after the site construction. The Committee had no objections, and no citizens showed up to speak of these routes. Routes recommended for approval.

#### **TEP Barnett**

Julie Jones with Total Energy presented the proposed temporary transportation route and the proposed permanent route for their Aussie site. This route needed to be discussed as it is part of an agreement between City Parks and TEP Barnett that is scheduled to be reviewed by City Council. The Committee had no objections and no citizens appeared to protest of these routes. Both the temporary route and the proposed permanent route were recommended for approval.
