April marked the start of our Concept Floor at Future City Hall, and we are excited to have YOU visit!


#### What is the Concept Floor?

- We know that while exciting, change is always hard, and we want to take this opportunity to experience the new space with you.


#### **How can I see the Concept Floor?**

Can I provide feedback on the Concepts?


Yes, there is a tailored QR code at each space type on the floor for you to provide feedback to help finalize the furniture options and layouts for your teams.

# You Asked, We Answered!

Each communication, we share questions submitted by City staff, answered by our team. We love hearing from you, so please keep them coming!

This month's questions are:

Q: How will access to my floor work? Can anyone walk onto my floor as they do today?

A: Future City Hall will be a public building with resident access to all floors as needed. However, through carefully designed access control and guided signage, we hope to guide visitors to the right location, minimizing some of the lost visitors we have at current City Hall today.

Q: When I move, what happens to our current building?

A: This will depend on where you work today. The City currently plans to keep and repurpose the current City Hall but will be looking to sell nine other properties within the downtown campus. This relocation will also include vacating several leased spaces.
