SPECIAL NOTE: To be selected for a Police Academy Training Class, applicants must successfully pass a written or electronic exam, a physical assessment test, a polygraph examination, an interview board, a medical examination, a psychological examination and an extensive background check.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: **High school diploma;** (or GED Certificate, plus 12 semester hours, with a “C” average, from an accredited college or university).

RESIDENCY: If employed as a Fort Worth Police Officer you must live within thirty (30) minutes of a designated report-in station; must be accomplished within six (6) months of employment.

CITIZENSHIP: Must be a U. S. Citizen at the time of application. (Must be able to read and write the English Language).

AGE: 20 – 45 years of age; **(Must be 20 years of age and not be 45 years of age by the date of your assigned Entry-Level Test/Civil Service; Examination: February 10th, 11th, 15th, 16th, 17th 2021)**

LICENSE: Must present a valid and current driver’s license and possess an acceptable driving record.

VETERAN: Must have received an Honorable Discharge to qualify for veteran points on a passing score.
*In order to receive veteran points, you must email your DD214 showing character of service (Member 4 or equivalent) to backgroundunit@fortworthtexas.gov **no later than 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 9th, 2021.** Please include your name and best contact number in the email. DD214s will not be accepted on the day of the examination.*

Exams will be conducted in strict accordance with CDC Guidelines as qualified applicants will be required to wear a mask during the entire time of the examination process, must adhere to assigned social distancing requirements as instructed, and will have their temperature checked upon entry of the testing site. Qualified applicants that fail to comply with or do not meet the CDC Guidelines will not be permitted to take the exam nor take a make-up or alternate exam for this recruiting cycle.
