#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must be a U. S. Citizen at the time of application. (Must be able to speak, read and write the English Language).
- 20 less than 45 YEARS OF AGE (Must be 20 years of age and cannot yet be 45 years of age by the date of your assigned Entry-Level Test/Civil Service Examination: March 10, 11, 12, 2020.)
- Valid and Current Driver's License
  - Must have an acceptable driving record.
- High school diploma; (or GED Certificate, plus 12 college semester hours, with at least a "C" average).

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must live within thirty (30) minutes of a designated report-in station;
  - o Must be accomplished within six (6) months of employment.
- Successfully pass a written test, a physical assessment test, a polygraph examination, an interview board, a medical examination, a psychological examination and an extensive background check.

### **ADDITIONAL EXAM POINTS:**

Additional points up to a maximum of five (5) cumulative points shall be added to a passing exam score as follows:

- > **Residency** = Three(3) points for residents who lived in the City of Fort Worth for a minimum of six (6) continuous months prior to March 10, 2020.

  - Associate's degree or 60+ hours of college credit = One (1) point
  - o Bachelor's degree (or higher) = Three (3) points

    position in modified hiring process).
  - Current licensed State jailers, police or fire telecommunicators, and prior law enforcement officers
     Two (2) points so long as applicants was not terminated for reasons that would be violations of FWPD general orders.
