**\*SAFE HARBOR COURT\*** Anyone who has outstanding citations with the Fort Worth Municipal Court may appear at a municipal court location or Court in the Community event, without fear of arrest for their cases, to resolve their outstanding cases and may be eligible for alternatives such as community service or a reduction in their fine based on ability to pay.

# Court in the Community - FAQs



## **Q. Is this only for Fort Worth citations?**

**A.** Yes, for any Class C criminal case filed with the Court such as traffic violations, ordinance violations, and penal code violations through the issuance of a citation.

## **Q. What is Safe Harbor?**

**A.** Fort Worth is a Safe Harbor Court, meaning residents can always visit a City of Fort Worth Municipal Court location without fear of arrest for outstanding warrants issued by the Fort Worth Municipal Court.
