



Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) Program

The Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) program funds units of general local governments, public housing authorities, local mental health authorities, and nonprofits wishing to provide the following services to individuals in their local communities:

TBRA is a rental subsidy used to help households obtain or maintain permanent housing, including assistance for shared housing arrangements, in the private rental housing market until they are able to enroll in the HCV Program or other affordable housing programs. Under TBRA, the household selects a housing unit of their choice. If the household moves out of the unit, payments to the owner will end and the household can move with continued assistance to another unit. In other words, TBRA is portable and moves with the household.
