### Individual Dock Owner Requirements

Dredging along the sides of individual boat docks and the dredging of channels for future boat dock construction within the Boat Dock Dredging Zone shall be the sole responsibility of the individual dock owner.

Lakeside property owners/leasers who do not currently have a boat dock may elect to have a 30 ft. wide channel cut in the Boat Dock Dredging Zone at an agreed upon location in order to facilitate future dock construction and access to the General Recreational Use Zone of the lake (see graphic).

Dredging work along the sides of individual boat docks shall be kept at the minimum required to provide access to the sides of individual docks.

The individual dock owner may contract with an dredge contractor of his/her choice.

The dredging must be done within the time frame specified by the LWMO and the dredging method and disposal site must be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the USACE permit issued to the FWWD.

The individual dock owner shall require his/her dredging contractor to provide a graphic of the area to be dredged and the calculated quantities of material to be removed to the LWMO for review and approval.

The individual dock owner's dredge contractor shall utilize sediment screens at both the dredge and disposal sites during all dredging and disposal operations.
