
Announcements

Movement Area Driving

- Beginning January 1, 2024, Spinks Airport will require driver training for all employees, businesses, and tenants
 that have a business-related reason and request movement area driving access. The purpose of the training is
 to provide documentation for airport compliance and ensuring proper knowledge of the airport environment
 prior to personnel utilizing surfaces intended for aircraft.
- Study materials will be provided, and a proctored test shall be passed prior to receiving access for driving on the movement areas. Test can be scheduled with Spinks operations by calling 817-392-5433 or emailing the address below.
- Training should be completed prior to January to ensure uninterrupted access needed to conduct business on the airport.
