Dear Mr. McElroy:

Thank you for your email transmitting the City of Fort Worth's City Council Resolution No. 5866-01-2024 of January 9, 2024, providing for the designation of the Fort Worth Convention Center as a venue project and designating the method of financing for that Venue Project pursuant to Chapter 334 of the Local Government Code.

The Resolution provides that the City of Fort Worth, subject to approval at an election, would impose a short term hotel occupancy tax, under the provisions of Subchapter H, at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) to finance the Venue Project.

Pursuant to Section 334.022 of the Texas Local Government Code, the Resolution has been reviewed. The Comptroller's Office has determined that the approval and implementation of the Resolution would have no significant negative impact on state revenue.
