LIVE RELEASE RATE SOARS IN 2025

FWACC is celebrating major progress in saving animal lives. The live release rate **climbed to 85.47%** in Fiscal Year 2025, up from 80.23% the year before. This achievement reflects incredible teamwork across FWACC, where staff and volunteers work tirelessly to give every pet a second chance. Innovative programs like the Chip Spot at Winslow's Café help reunite lost pets with their families, while P.A.W.S. for Patriots connects shelter animals with veterans, and P.A.W.S. and Think teaches students about responsible pet ownership. Together, these efforts are helping more pets find loving homes than ever before.

The City of Fort Worth's Mobile Tool Shed program expanded citywide, giving all residents free access to lawn care and property maintenance tools.
