SUCCESS AT MEGA

FWACC celebrated 45 dog adoptions at the Humane Society of North Texas' MEGA Adoption Event, where nearly 1,000 animals from shelters across North Texas were brought together over two days. In total, 833 animals found homes, including 491 dogs, 334 cats and eight small animals. For many adopters, the event offered an unexpected opportunity to connect with a pet they hadn't planned on adopting, but who ultimately stole their hearts.

In August, 35 Tool Shed reservations were successfully completed, giving Fort Worth residents free access to the tools they needed to mow, clean up and bring their properties into compliance.
