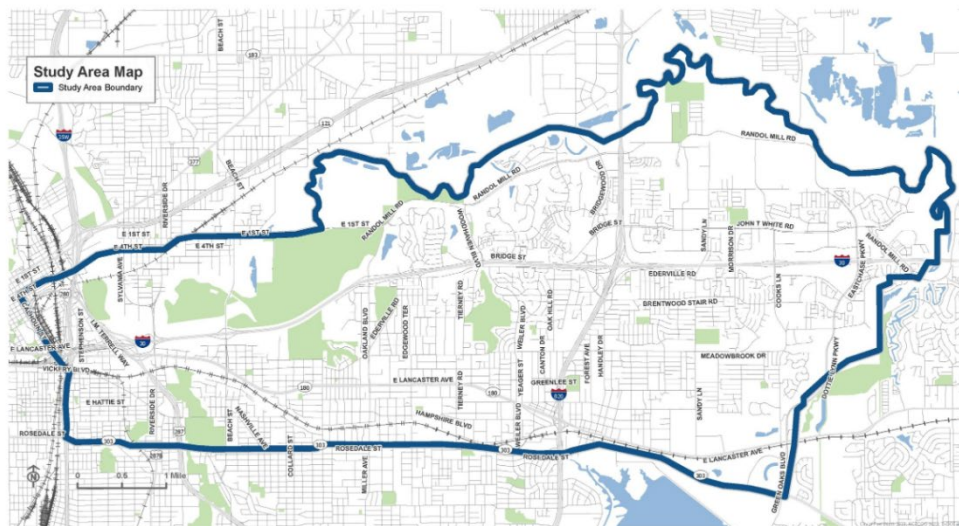

Intent of Plan: The Plan will evaluate the potential of high-capacity transit (HCT), improvements for other facilities in the study area, and supportive economic development and land use policies. The study will also develop consensus-based solutions for pedestrian facilities along Randol Mill Road in the Woodhaven area. The process must be transparent and inclusive to adhere to requirements of National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.
