

STORM WATER IMPERVIOUS COVER SITE PLAN CHECKLIST FOR NEW DEVELOPMENT AND ADDITIONS

A site plan showing impervious areas on a site is required by the City of Fort Worth for the purpose of calculating storm water fees. *This site plan can be an Architectural / Landscape either in hard copy or preferably digital format (.PDF, .TIFF, etc.) meeting the follow criteria:*

- 1.) Site plan <u>MUST</u> be to scale, showing a north arrow, the complete street address, and boundary street names. *No hand drawn site plans will be accepted.*
- 2.) Site plans must be in their entirety on one page for each parcel. All parcel boundary lines <u>MUST</u> be clearly marked and shown. *Plans with unclear parcel boundary lines or parcel boundary lines that are cut off will <u>not</u> be accepted.*
- 3.) Site plan <u>MUST</u> clearly delineate impervious areas. Cluttered site plans that interfere with the legibility of impervious surface will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- 4.) Where possible, the name of the proposed business (i.e. Wal-Mart, George Washington High School, etc.) should be identified within the site plan.

IMPORTANT: Failure to meet any criteria on this checklist will be grounds to place holds on the building permit.
