SUBJECT: (CD 8 and 9) Approve Allocation of \$4,000,000.00 in American Rescue Plan Act

Funding for Capital Improvements at Cobb Park, Highland Hills Park, and the Fort Worth Zoo; Adopt Appropriation Ordinances, and Amend the Fiscal Years 2022-2026 Capital

Improvement Plan

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Approve the allocation of \$4,000,000.00 from the American Rescue Plan Act funds, Subtitle M (Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds) for a transfer to capital for capital improvements at Cobb Park, Highland HIlls Park and the Fort Worth Zoo;
- 2. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Grants Capital Projects Federal Fund, transferred from the Grants Operating Federal Fund in the amount of (1) \$1,500,000.00, for the purpose of funding the Cobb Park Road and Parking Reconstruction Project; (2) \$1,000,000.00 for the Highland Hills and Parking Reconstruction project, and (3) \$1,500,000.00 for the Fort Worth Zoo ARPA project; and
- 3. Amend the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget and Fiscal Years 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to approve the allocation of \$4,000,000.00 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds, Subtitle M (Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds) for a transfer to capital for Cobb Park road and parking reconstruction. Highland Hills Park road and parking reconstruction, and improvements at the Fort Worth Zoo which include bridge, erosion, and road improvements and the installation of broadband.

ALLOCATION OF ARPA SUBTITLE M FUNDING

In March 2021, the President signed the American Rescue Plan Act, providing aid and relief to various sectors of the United States economy. The City of Fort Worth's allocation from these funds totals \$173,745,090.00, of which a first tranche (50\%), in the amount of \$86,872,545.00, was received on May 19, 2021.

Subsequently, M&C 21-0445 was adopted on June 22, 2021, establishing a framework for the use of ARPA funding. That M&C identified categories of projects intended to assist in the on-going recovery effort to strengthen the physical and economic health of the community, including Majority Minority Area (MMA) Infrastructure Projects and Park Development. The PARD projects are Cobb Park road and parking reconstruction and Highland Hills Park road and parking reconstruction, both of which enhance access to parks in MMA areas, which is an allowed use under ARPA guidance as MMAs were generally harder hit by the pandemic.

Staff is also recommending projects at the Fort Worth Zoo that include road and bridge improvements, erosion control, and broadband improvements. The projects would be considered to be funded out of the revenue-replacement portion of the City's ARPA dollars under Subsection 603(c)(1)(C) of Title VI of the Social Security Act (added by ARPA) although they might arguably also qualify as expenses toward recover of the COVID-impacted tourism economy under 603(c)(1)(A)...

The ARPA funding must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026. Staff foresees no issues with these projects meeting that timeline.
