A5	Have a written policy to monitor departing patrons and prevent alcohol containers from being removed from the establishment.		10

A7	Have a written policy empowering and encouraging staff to offer free or reduced-price non-alcoholic beverages to designated drivers.		10	
A8	Have a written policy and a posted maximum drink policy prohibiting customers from possessing two mixed beverages at one time.		10	
A9	Have a written policy requiring security staff to complete enhanced nightlife security training courses and background checks.		10	
A10	Have a written policy to ensure staff is aware of the risk of domestic and sexual assault that can occur on the premises. This policy also requires that all staff attend active bystander intervention training to prevent sexual and domestic assault and sexual harassment when appropriate.		10	
A11	Have a written policy to ensure staff is aware and understands how to prevent the risk of drink spiking.		10	
A12	Have a written policy to ensure staff is aware of human trafficking. This policy also requires that all staff complete the TABC human trafficking education course.		10	
A13	Have a written policy that requires all staff to take the Fort Worth Nightlife Safety Pledge to ensure all employees and patrons feel welcome, safe, and free of harassment.		10	
A14	Have a written policy regarding weapons found on the premises or removed from patrons.		10	

A15	Have a written policy establishing when to call the Fort Worth Police Department to the establishment.		10	
A16	Have a written policy that addresses the preservation of a crime scene, including witnesses, until police arrive. At a minimum, the procedure must include: 1. Instructions to remove patrons and staff from the area during and after the incident 2. The requirement to call the police and fire department immediately 3. Preservation of crime scene, potential evidence, and witnesses		10	
A17	If the establishment utilizes a security video system, have a written policy detailing how police collect that data.		10	
A18	Have a written policy requiring staff to fill out an "in-house" incident report if any of the following circumstances occur: • Sexual assault • Drink spiking • A patron is evicted or refuses to leave the premises • Overly intoxicated patrons consuming alcohol on the premises • A fight, assault, or disturbance occurs • Police are called to the establishment • A patron using illegal drugs while on the property • Illegal drugs seized on the property • Trespassing • A weapon is discovered in the establishment or on a patron • Disorderly conduct		10	
A19	Have a written policy for the use of identification scanners to verify the age and validity of patron identifications.		10	
A20	Have a written policy for the use of metal detectors, pat downs, and bag searches.		10	

A21	Have a written policy for the use of Naloxone (Narcan®) that covers storage, accessibility, and staff training.		10	
A22	Have a written glass collection policy ensuring bottles and glassware are removed from tables frequently.		10	
A23	Have a written dispersal policy.		10	
A24	Have a written and posted policy for handling or cleaning up bodily fluids (blood, vomit, urine, etc.).		10

A26	Have a policy for participation in a patron exclusionary program such as Fort Worth Bar Safe.		10	
A27	Have a policy to prevent patrons from drinking and driving.		10

B1	Incident reporting binder or electronic filing system to document incidents.		10	

B2	Binder or electronic filing system to track TABC seller/server certification program or TIPS training for staff.		10

B4	Binder or electronic filing system for keeping track of banned patrons.		10	
B5	Require that all staff members who are certified to serve alcohol in your establishment sign and abide by an Alcohol Serving Principles Document.		10	
B6	Maintain a list of staff who have attended general staff meetings to review policies or changes in policy.		10	
B7	Maintain records of how you promote the Golden Lasso Accreditation Program. This may include social media, advertisements, or other promotional events.		10	
B8	Patron count log, binder, or electronic filing system to track occupancy loads.		10	
B9	Maintain a list of all staff who have valid first aid and CPR certifications.		10

C1	The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission permit must be clearly posted.		10	
C2	The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission's "Health Risk Warning" sign must be clearly posted.		10	
C3	The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission's "Public Information - Complaint" sign must be clearly posted.		10	
C4	The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission's "Human Trafficking Warning" sign must be clearly posted.		10	
C5	The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission's "Red Handgun 51%" sign must be clearly posted.		10	
C6	Have garbage cans near entrances and exits.		10	
C7	Have on-premises appropriate safety equipment, such as a first aid kit, flashlight, etc.		10	
C8	Support transportation programs such as Uber/Lyft or Mothers Against Drunk Driving impaired driving and underage drinking campaigns by posting applicable posters or signage at entrances and exits.		10	
C9	Clear trash in the areas surrounding the establishment daily at closing time.		10	
C10	Quickly address areas in the establishment that have been defaced or are in disrepair.		10
