

The City of Fort Worth invites interested residents to attend a public meeting about 1300 Gendy Street, where invited development firms will present their preliminary proposals to redevelop the City-owned property. The development firms will be selected by an evaluation panel consisting of City department heads and community leaders. Residents will have the opportunity to ask questions and submit comments during the public meeting.

Public participation is an important step in the selection process, and the City encourages interested residents to attend. The meeting will be recorded and posted on the webpage for those who can't attend. Beginning October 11, 2023, a comment form will be available at **fortworthtexas.gov/1300Gendy**. Residents who would like to submit their comments should use the online form and submit it to the email address provided on the form. The deadline to submit comments is 4 p.m. on October 16, 2023.
