REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must meet the minimum standards established in the Local Civil Service Rules by the Civil Service Commission of the City of Fort Worth, and as set out in the applicable the Collective Bargaining Agreement. A candidate must have a high school diploma, or equivalent (e.g., GED); and be at least 18 years of age, and must not have reached 36 years of age by the date of the entry-level test – December 15, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY LIST: Applicants meeting the minimum standards and who pass the exam will be placed on the eligibility list according to their examination score, including any additional points allowed. This list will be effective for twelve (12) months.

ADDITIONAL POINTS: Additional points up to a maximum of five (5) points shall be added to a passing exam score as follows:

Military Veteran (with honorable discharge per DD214) 5 points

Five (5) points will be added to a passing exam score of a military veteran who emails a copy of their DD-214 showing an honorable discharge to FWFDHiring@fortworthtexas.gov no later than December 14, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. DD214s submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

CONTENTS OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION: The examination will consist of 100 multiplechoice questions. A score of 70 percent or above is considered a passing score.

SPECIAL NOTE: All applicants must make arrangements to be present at the appointed time for the examination. ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRESENT

POSITIVE PICTURE IDENTIFICATION BEFORE BEING ADMITTED. Any exceptions must be approved by the Civil Service Director or his or her designee.

Accommodations:

- (c) No employee of the Human Resources Department, examiner or other person shall deceive or obstruct persons in their right to examination, eligibility, certification or appointment under this Article or furnish to any person any special or secret information for the purpose of affecting the rights or prospects of any person with respect to employment in the City service.
