CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSION:

- Participants under 18 must have parental permission to submit and release artwork.
- All work must be original, created by the submitting participant.
- All work must include an entry form.
- One entry per person.
- All artwork must be submitted on the template.
- No profanity or vulgar language, no copywritten imagery, no nudity, and no depictions of violence or weaponry.
- All entries must be submitted by Tuesday, March 31st before 6 p.m. Entries submitted later than this time will not be considered. Winners will be notified by May 1st.
- Submit online at fwpl.info/bookmark or in person at any Fort Worth Public Library.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Work will be judged in four categories by age: preschool, school age, teen, and adult.
- All submissions will be judged on creativity, originality, clarity and relevance to the theme.

- Winner's will have artwork printed on official FWPL bookmarks and distributed during the Summer Reading Challenge.
