SAFE HARBOR COURT Anyone who has outstanding citations with the Fort Worth Municipal Court may appear at a Municipal Court location or Court in the Community event, without fear of arrest for their cases, to resolve their outstanding cases and may be eligible for alternatives such as community service or a reduction in their fine based on ability to pay.

Q. Is this only for Fort Worth Municipal Court citations

A. Yes, 120 persons can be seen on a first come first served basis with a Class C criminal case filed with the Court such as traffic, ordinance, and penal code violations.
