SAFE HARBOR COURT Anyone who has outstanding citations with the Fort Worth Municipal Court may appear at a municipal court location or Court in the Community event, without fear of arrest for their cases, to resolve their outstanding cases and may be eligible for alternatives such as community service or a reduction in their fine based on ability to pay.

Other walk-up services that will be available with no appointment include :

General civil intake, including family law, wills and estates, landlord/tenant cases, public benefits, federal tax, bankruptcy, and real property matters.
