PROGRAM TIMELINE (3-YEAR CYCLE)

Year 1: Plan & Listen

- Make quick basic improvements (i.e. Cleanup litter and illegal dump, remove hazardous overgrowth)
- Connect with community organizations
- Identify projects and finalize project plans

Year 2: Design & Prepare

- Construct Projects
- Provide updates to the community

Year 3: Build & Deliver

- Construct projects
- Complete improvements
- Share results with the community
