














Super Majority Minority Areas, 2020








Population Density







Jobs Growth, 2018 - 2045





Housing Count by Sector, 2019


















Property Tax Rate Allocation 1990 - 2021



Net Taxable Value 1990 - 2020




Net Taxable Value per Capita 1990 - 2020





City Property Tax Revenue 2000 - 2020




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City Property Tax Revenue per Capita 2000 - 2020




City Sales Tax Revenue 1990 - 2020
