## **Recommended Policies**

- 1. Promote commercial and multifamily development within the Polytechnic/Texas Wesleyan, Loop 820 East/Lake Arlington, Miller/Berry mixed-use growth centers.
- 2. Promote industrial development within the Loop 820 East/Lake Arlington industrial growth center.

## **Recommended Strategies**

- 1. Encourage quality residential development along the west side of Lake Arlington which takes advantage of the scenic and recreational qualities.
- 2. Protect the environmental quality of Lake Arlington and the surrounding area.
- 3. Encourage attractive freeway commercial uses along East Loop 820.
- 4. Protect residential areas from commercial encroachment adjacent to Mansfield Highway, Wilbarger St., E. Berry St., and E. Rosedale St.
- 5. Promote a balance of residential, commercial and industrial uses in the Southeast sector.
- 6. Promote the expansion of the Polytechnic/ Texas Wesleyan educational complex.
- 7. Encourage marketable infill houses, particularly in the Polytechnic and Stop Six neighborhoods.
