

Project Limits






Project Scope and Goals

- Objectives include:
 - Improve traffic flow at the intersection during peak hours
 - Improve pedestrian safety by installing pedestrian-actuated signals with push buttons and ADA-compliant curb ramps
 - Improve left turning movements by implementation of the signal along Ray White Road

Typical Construction Process

- Notifications – Door hangers and Project Sign
- Traffic Control Implementation
- Traffic Signal installation and Roadway Construction
- Landscaping / Sodding
- Traffic Control Removal
- Final Clean Up



Project Schedule

- Projected Start: December 12, 2023
- Project Duration: 180 Calendar Days
- Projected Completion: June 2024
- Working Hours
 - 7 AM – 6 PM M-F (Standard Hours)
 - 9 AM – 5 PM (Weekend Hours if Requested in Writing and Approved)

 - Door Hangers on Residences and Businesses
