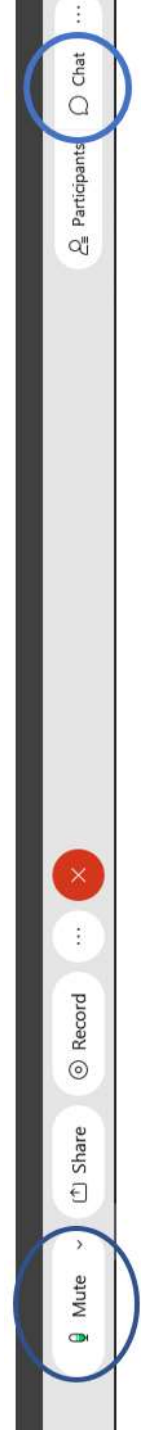

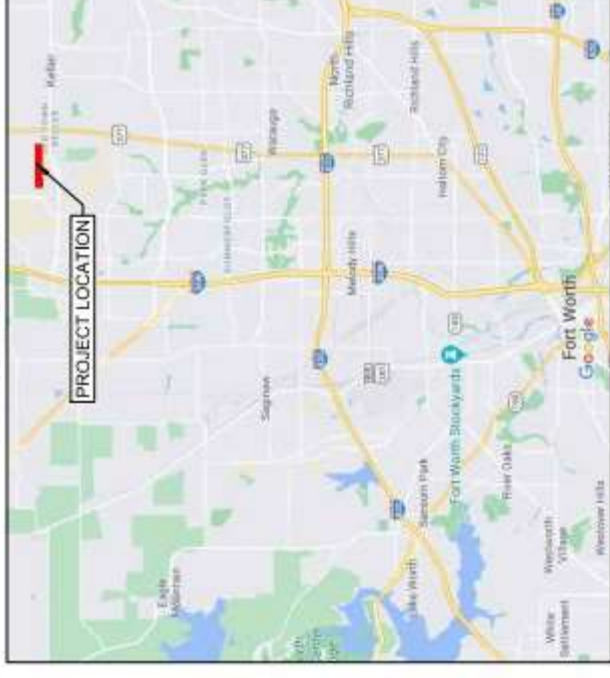

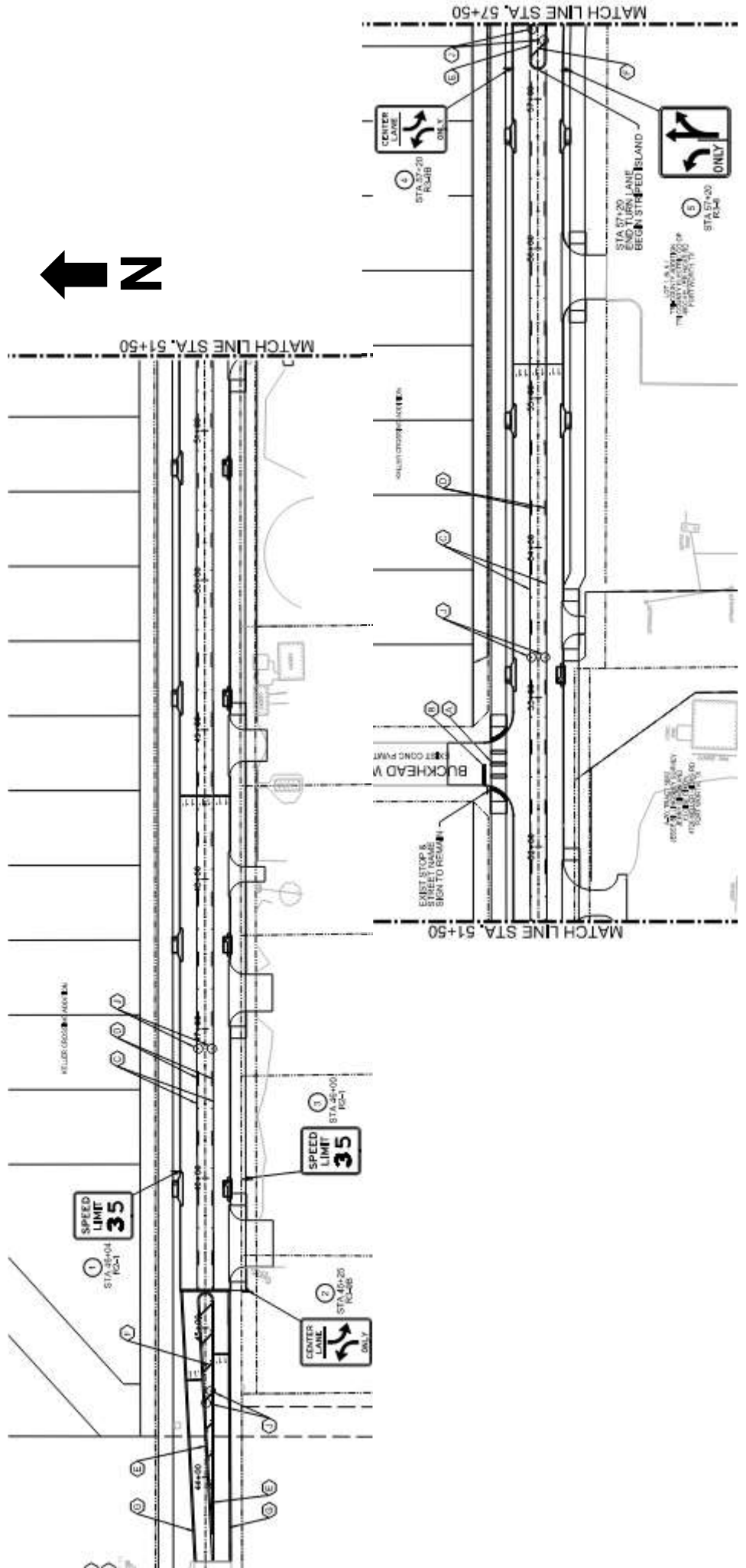
LOCATION MAP



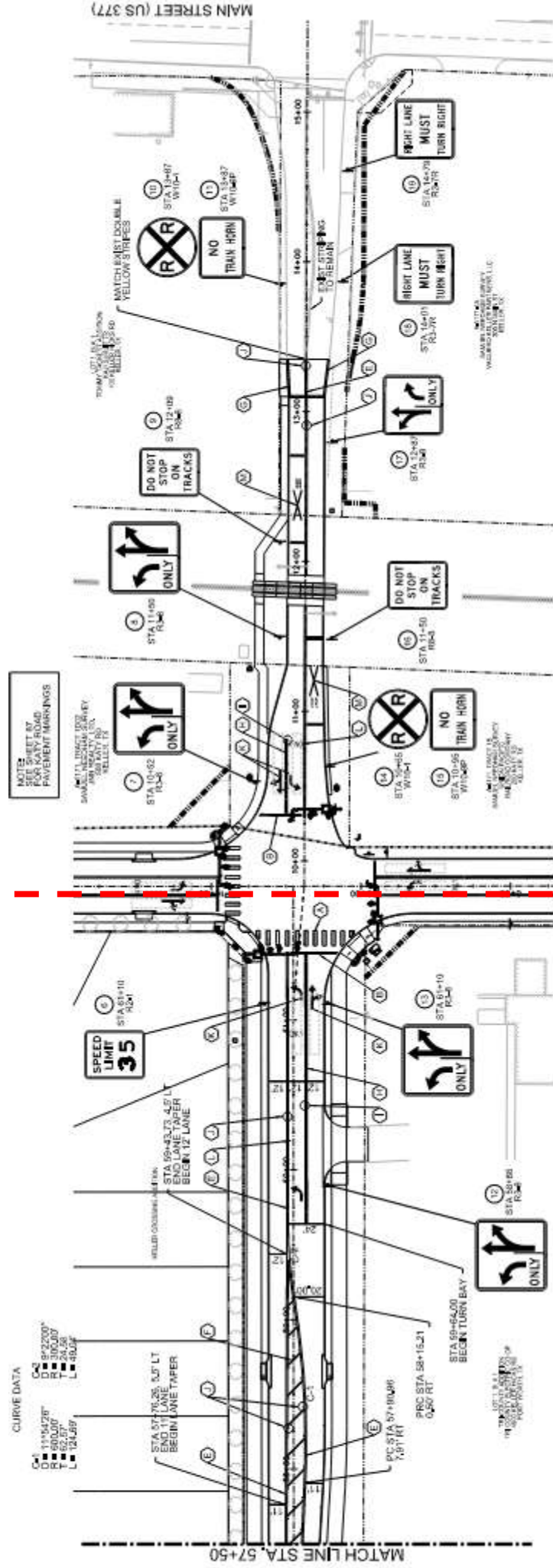
Keller Hicks Project Improvements

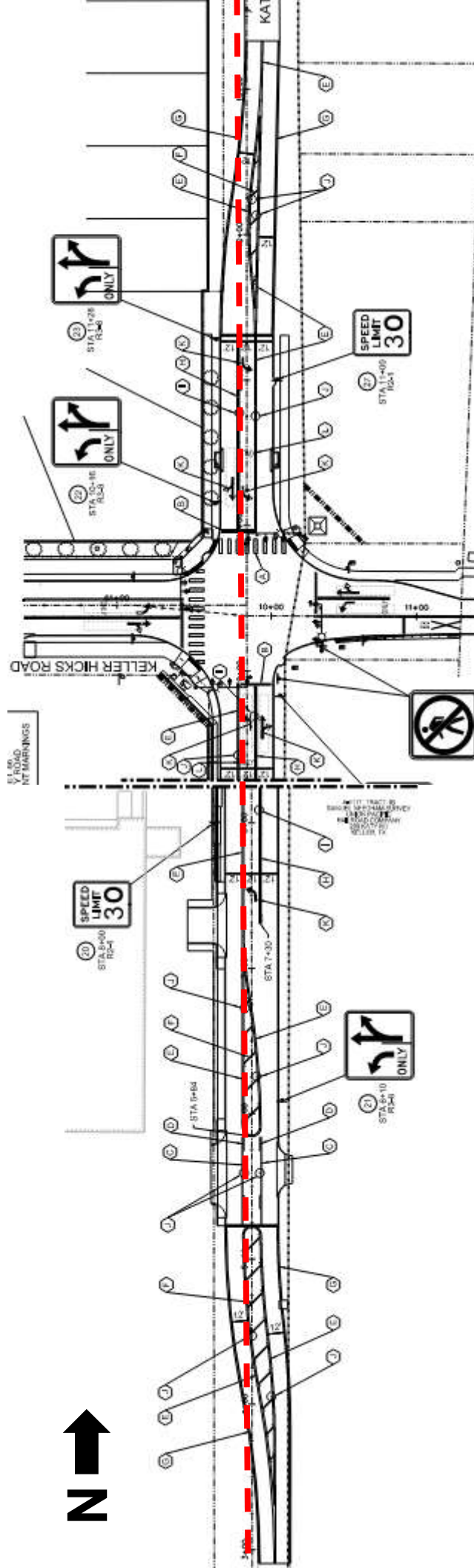

Keller Hicks Construction Phasing

- Closure of Keller Hicks (Between Lauren Way and Katy Road)
 - Roughly 3 Months Starting in Late January 2024
- Closure of Keller Hicks (Railroad Crossing)
 - Roughly 3 Months Starting in Summer 2024
 - Construction Start is Contingent on Railroad Contractor
- When Traffic is Open on Keller Hicks
 - Expect Westbound Traffic Only
- When Traffic is Open on Katy Road
 - Expect Southbound Traffic Only
