


Project Overview

- **❖** W Bewick St from Hemphill St to May St (2)
- **❖** W Bewick St from Henderson St to 5th Ave (3)
- **❖** McClure St from Elva Warren St to Debbie Dr (4)
- **❖** 5th Avenue from W Seminary Dr to Broadus St (5)
- **❖** Blodgett Ave 90 ft East of McClure to 215 ft east (6)
- **❖** Elva Warren St from McClure St to E Dead End (7)
- **❖** McClure St from Elva Warren St to 285ft north (8)
- **❖** Meriwether Ave from E Dead End to Berke Rd (9)















Project Phase	Timeframe
Receive 90% Design Plans	November 2023
Advertise for Bids	February 2024
Receive Bids	March 2024
Council Approval	May 2024
Award Construction Contract	June 2024
Begin Construction	October 2024
Complete Construction	January 2026
