A. Selection Process

- The City reserves the right to reject any or all submittals "nonresponsive"
- Evaluation Committee to score only responsive proposals
- Short-listed interviews (if needed), in-person or virtually
 - Tentatively: Wednesday, July 5, 2023 or Thursday, July 6, 2023 and will determine the top-ranked firm
- Five (5) days minimum notice for shortlisted interviewees



B. Proposal Requirements

- 1. Cover Letter and Executive Summary (not to exceed 3 pages)
 - Cover letter (1 page)
 - Executive summary of two (2) pages or less
- 2. Approach and Process
- 3. Responsibility and Qualifications
- 4. Prior Experience
- 5. References (1 page)
 - Two (2) of the three (3) should be public sector clients
- 6. Budget \$850,000
- 7. Minority/Women Business Enterprise (WBE) (MBE)/Goals 10%
- 8. Conflict of Interests Form



C. Proposal

- Written Proposal Total Points 100 points
 - Previous Experience 15 points
 - Effective Planning Process and Project Development Outcomes 30 points
 - Project Management/Availability of Consultant(s) 30 points
 - Work Quality and References 15 points
 - Additional Services, Ideas, Innovation or Products 10 points
- Interview Points (if needed*) 25 points



Scope Overview (Hot Corridor)

- Duration: 14 months total for kick off through adoption (12 month core planning process)
- Conceptual Design for the street corridor, including identification of right-ofway and utility relocation
- Multimodal design operations, autos, ped/bike, transit, and micromobility
- Identifying economic development opportunities
- Form-based code for the McCart Ave at key nodes, includes parts of Atlamesa
- Studying opportunities for Smart City applications, including fiber-readiness.
- Funding ready project list and program



Process

- 1. Public and Stakeholder Outreach (focus groups, surveys, etc.)
- 2. Discovery, Existing/Baseline Conditions, and Needs Assessment
- 3. Corridor and Node(s) Concept Plan
- Implementation Plan, Form-Based Code, Phasing, and Final Report
