Project Scope Overview

Scope

- **Before:** Asphalt mill & overlay + streetscape (sidewalks, ADA ramps, bike lanes, signals, ped lights, improved streetlights).
- **Now:** Full concrete roadway reconstruction + same streetscape improvements.
- **Why:** Community requested concrete pavement.

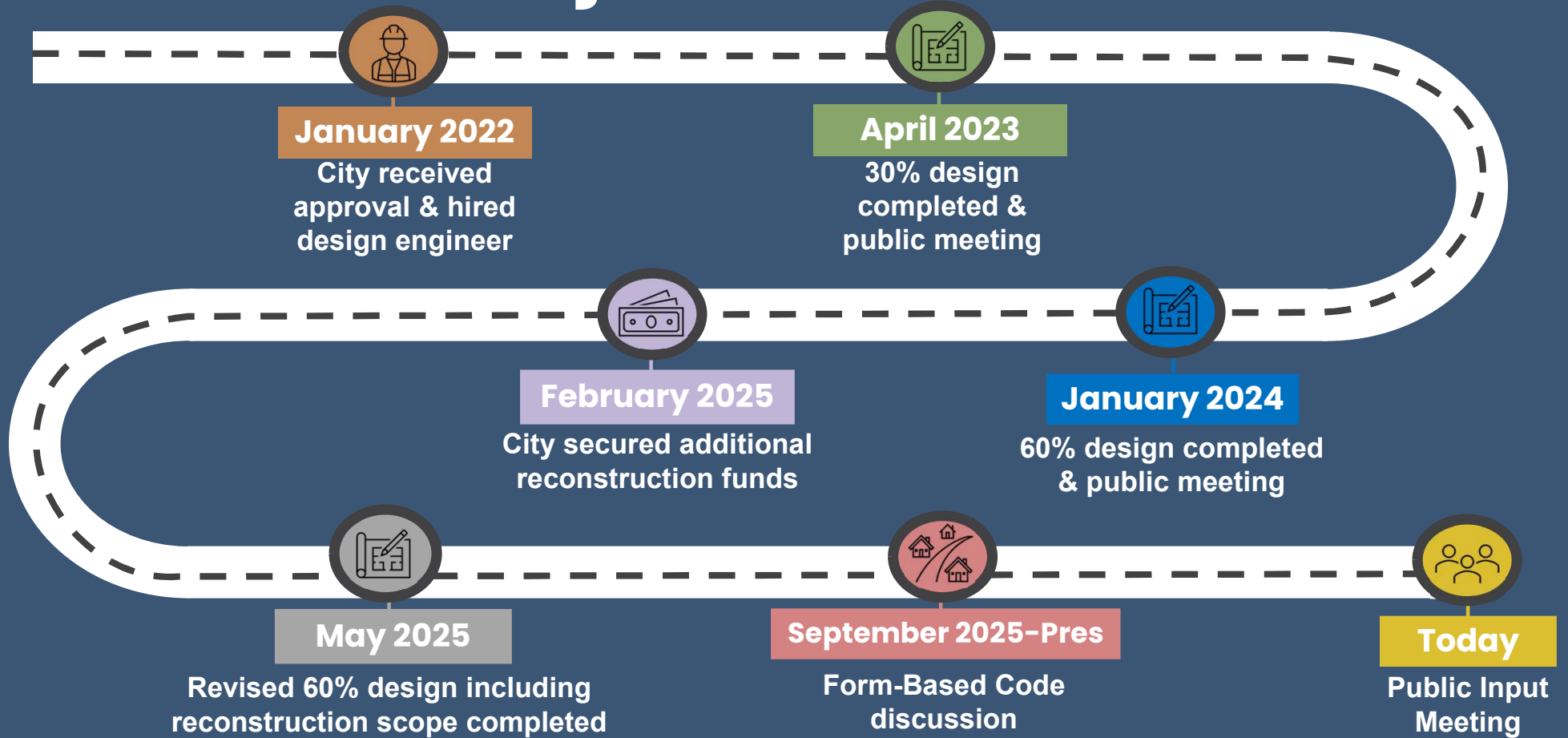
Project Team

- **Before:** Capital Delivery – Mobility
- **Now:** Capital Delivery – Neighborhood Street
- **Why:** Scope Change from mill & overlay to full roadway reconstruction

Funding

- **Before:** Federal – \$10,771,829
- **Now:** Federal + City – \$20,174,274
- **Why:** Covers cost increase for full reconstruction

Form-Based Code Elements

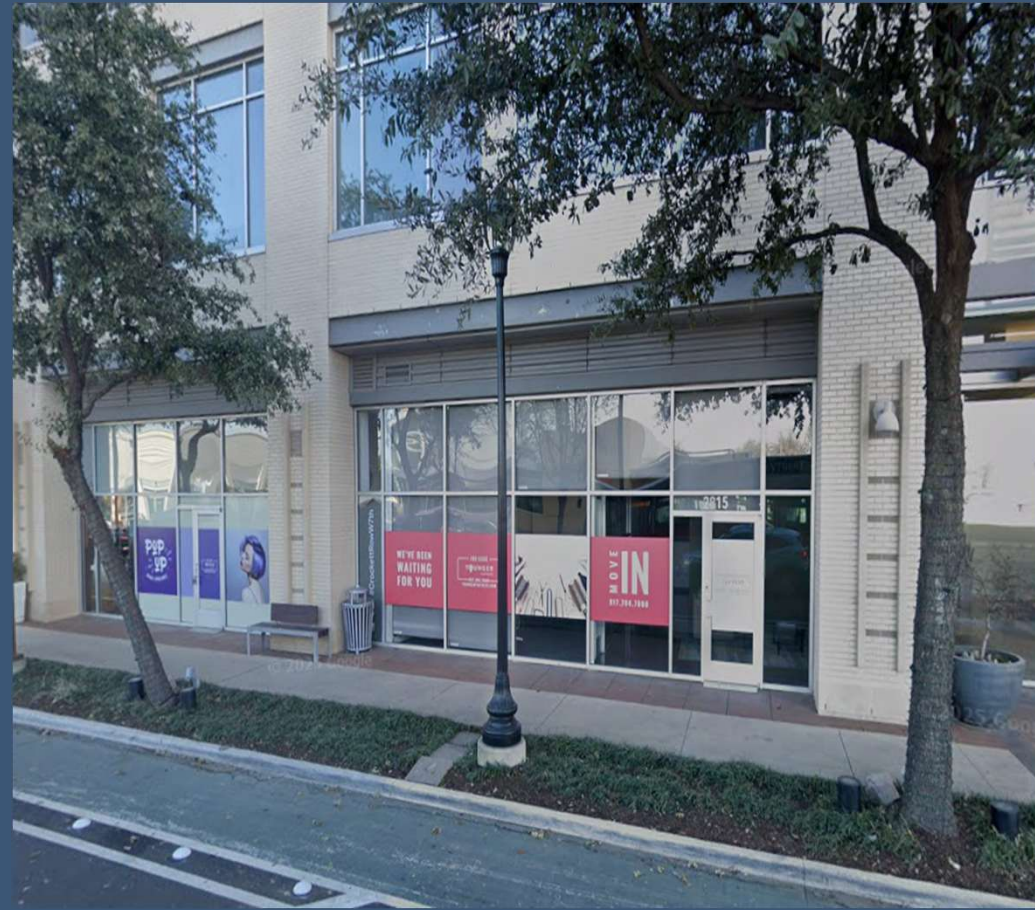
SIDEWALK PLACEMENT

➤ Zoning Requirement

- 6-ft sidewalk along the property line, with grass between the curb and sidewalk; trees spaced every 40 ft.

➤ Current Design

- Sidewalk width requirement is met but placed behind the curb

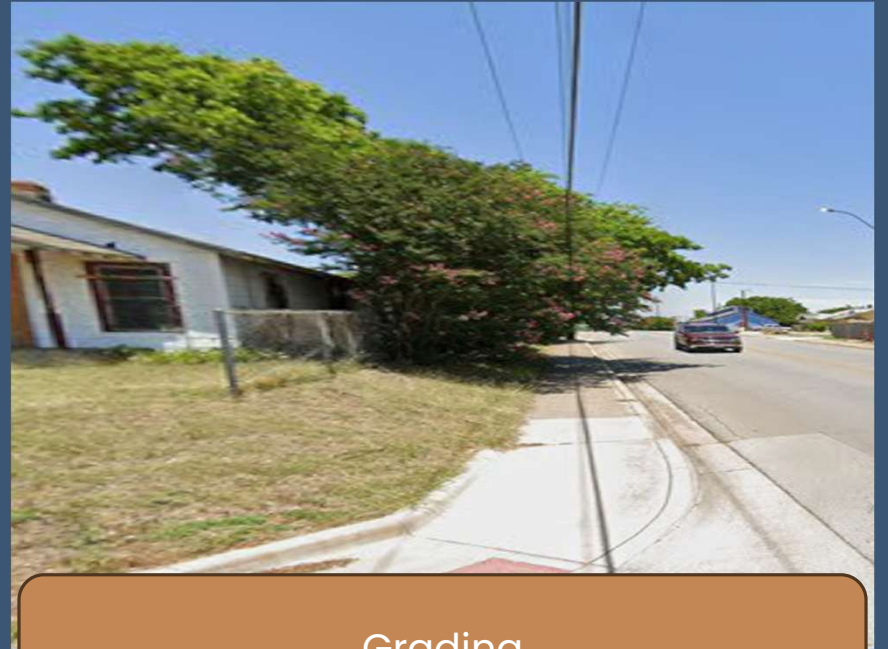

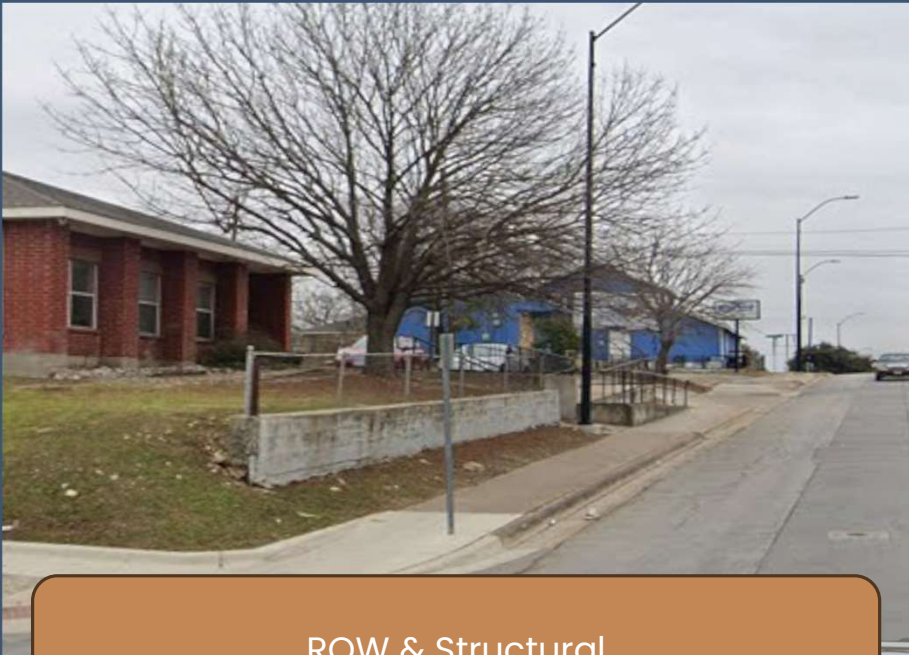

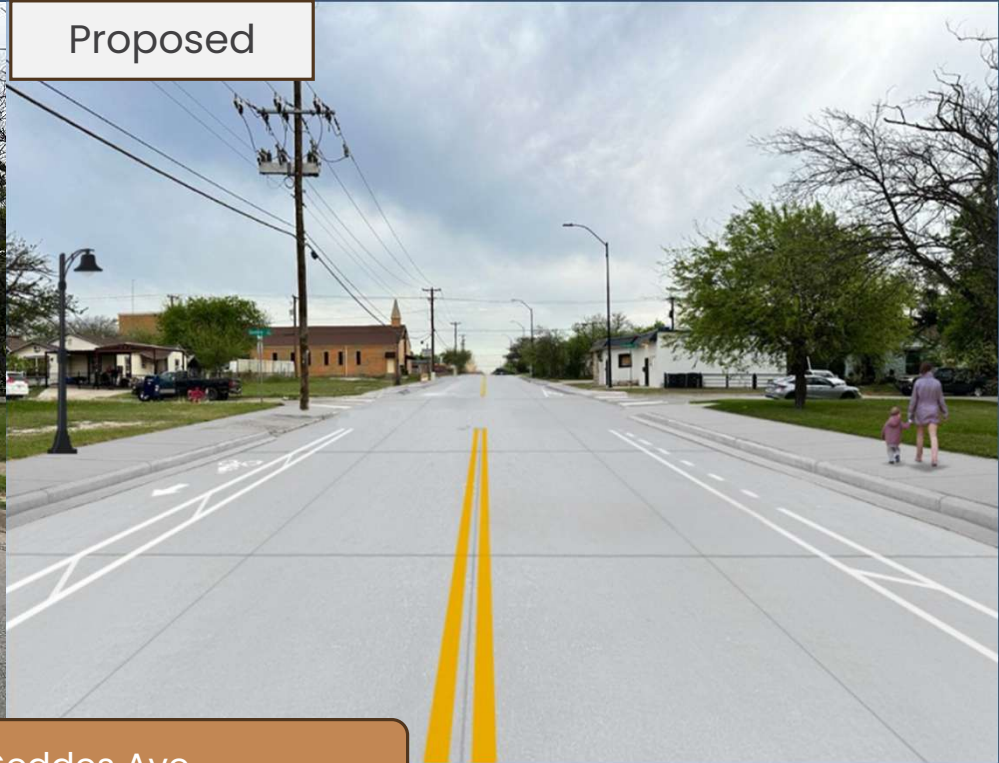

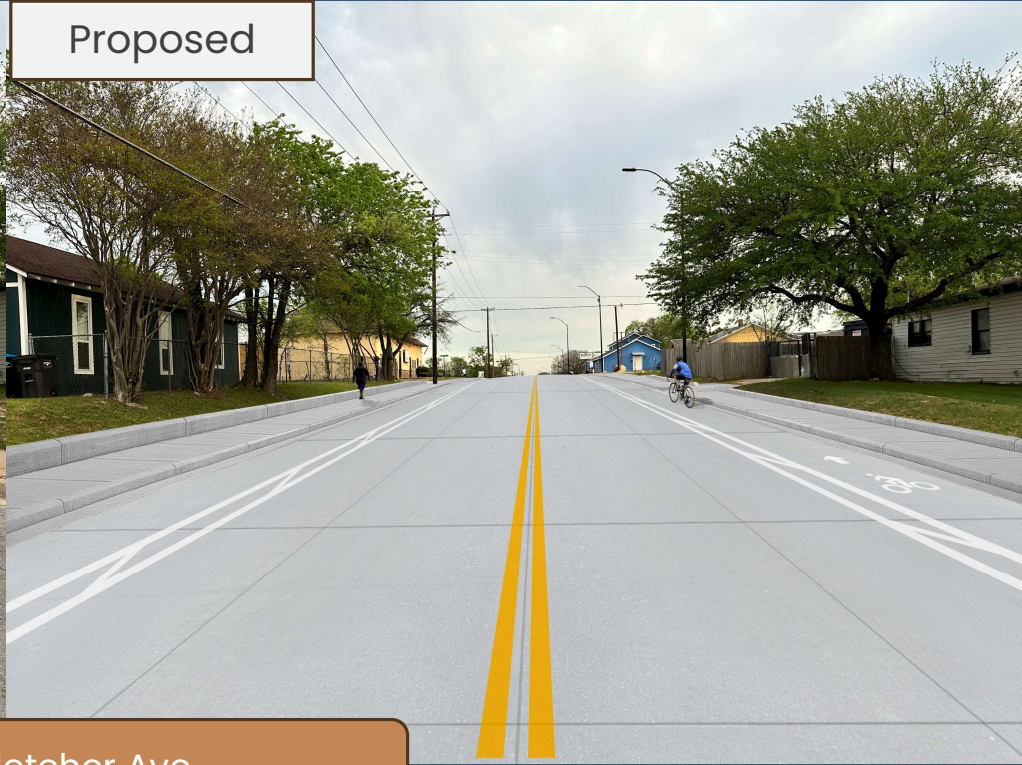
