



PROJECT PURPOSE

The project will widen the existing roadway to a four-lane divided roadway.

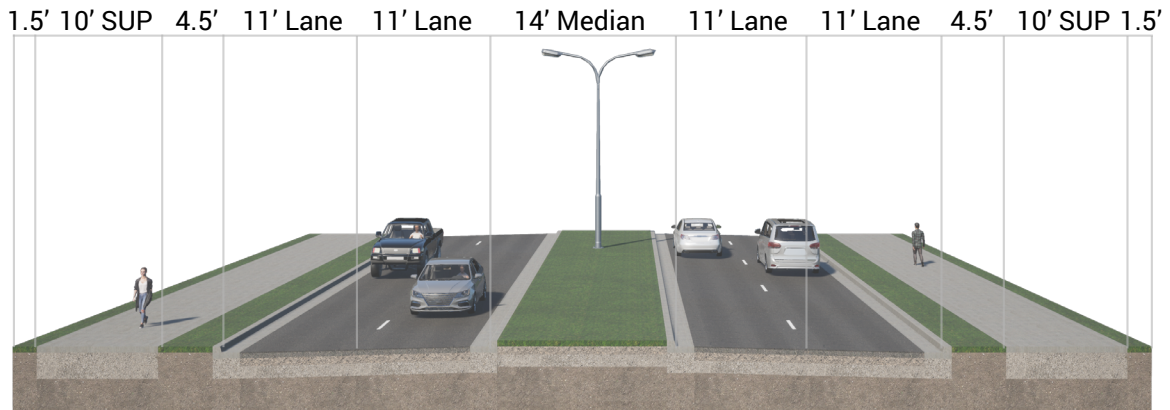
PROJECT OVERVIEW

Limits: Boat Club Rd (FM 1220) to 600 Feet East of Elkins School Rd

Length: ~1 mile

Proposed Cross Section:

- » Two 11' travel lanes in each direction
- » 14' Median
- » One 10' shared-use path on both sides
- » 90' right-of-way

PROJECT BENEFITS

- » Increases traffic capacity, optimizes traffic flow, and reduces congestion on parallel roadways.
- » Trails and sidewalks support walking, biking, and accessibility to local destinations.
- » Drainage improvements (culvert upgrades, ditch elimination) mitigate flooding risks.

The project area is located within the 100-year floodplain associated with Marine Creek.
