Project Goals

- 2022 Bond Program
 - Anticipated \$15M for construction
- Raise Wagley Robertson Road out of the floodplain
 - Current roadway is approximately 2.5' below the ultimate 100-year water surface elevation
- Widen Wagley Robertson per the MTP
 - NCO-L2-TO-NTMS-PO-BOP (110)
 - 4-lane divided roadway section with sidepath on both sides of roadway
 - Approximately 2,000 LF project length
 - Raised median
 - 110' ROW


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

Project Overview and Location Map









