DG23 – 008 1116 Houston Street (H)
Downtown Urban District overlay
Council District: 9
Owner / Applicant: AT&T / James Anderson, The Beck Group.

Requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for the following:

- 1) exterior building improvements, consisting of blast resistant film on glazing and landscaping improvements consisting of replacing vegetation in planters with tree grates and decorative stone; and
- 2) a waiver from the façade standards to allow the closing of existing openings at ground level of the façades facing Throckmorton Street and W 11th Street with stone veneer instead of the requirement that the ground floor buildings include architectural relief at least every 30 feet.

DG23 – 009 320 Samuels Avenue (H)
Downtown Urban District overlay
Council District: 9
Owner / Applicant: Avid Hotels / Michael Cato, A&M Signs.

Requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for the following:

- 1) a comprehensive sign plan for new signage;
- 2) a waiver from the crown of building sign standards to allow signs with an area of 119.71 square feet instead of the maximum allowed sign area of 100 square feet for an 18 to 100 foot tall building;
- 3) a waiver to the crown of building sign standards to allow two (2) horizontal lines of letters or symbols instead of the one (1) horizontal line of letters or symbols allowed;
- 4) a waiver from the plaque sign standards to allow a sign with a projection of 2 1/8 inches instead of the maximum allowed projection of two (2) inches;
- 5) a waiver from the plaque sign standards to allow a sign with a height of 2 feet 3 1/2 inches instead of the maximum allowed height of two (2) feet; and
- 6) a waiver from the plaque sign standards to allow a sign with a width of 2 feet 3 1/2 inches instead of the maximum allowed width of two (2) feet.
