- 1. Request a Certificate of Appropriateness for the construction of a new single-family home.
- 2. Request the following waivers from the Downtown Urban Design District Standards and Guidelines:
 - a) A waiver from the Building Height, Massing, Orientation, and Setback Standards to allow a roof pitch with a design that is inconsistent with those predominantly found on the block.
 - b) A waiver from the Building Material Standards to allow a building envelope (container home) that is inconsistent with those traditionally found in the district.
 - c) A waiver from the Sidewalk Standards to install a five-foot-wide sidewalk instead of the requirement of a seven-foot-wide sidewalk.
