Suggestions for keeping the Vehicle Log:

- The log should be kept for at least 30 consecutive days
- Multiple daily observations should be noted if possible, e.g., 6 a.m., 3 p.m., 10 p.m.
- To indicate overnight stays, it is best to log vehicles late in the evening and first thing in the morning
- Date and time stamped digital or printed pictures are helpful to back up log entries
- Be careful to only log vehicles that belong to the occupants of the subject address
