




Stacking Plan

Stacking Plan Update

- 19th floor to be available this fall rather than 2029;
 - M&C on August 22 Council agenda for early termination
- Finalizing any adjusted floor plans
- Finalizing move timelines off this adjusted stack; move vendor to be onboarded this month
- Provides best flexibility for City growth
- 18th floor could be vacated by tenant lease ending in Q3 of 2025
- Mayor and Council floor move on track to take place just after the holidays, with other departments moving in through the remainder of 2024










Council Chambers Progress Update

- Federal permit granted 7/25
- Grading started immediately following permit
- Building pad work started 8/9
- Pier drilling starts end of August
- Superstructure starts end of November
- First chamber meetings targeted for Winter 2024-2025


Public Communications Updates

Concept Rooms Installed


- Rooms 376 and 380 of current City Hall have been retrofit with the new solution planned for Future City Hall
- Room scheduling, voice activated join, and multi content share capabilities
- This a preview of what is to come for our public, staff, and elected officials in the new building





Management Forum Overview

- City will be hosting a management forum in October to help prepare employee leaders for the transition in way of work at Future City Hall
- The forum will include supervisors, managers, and above to better inform them of the preparations prior to moving to Future City Hall
- As part of the prep for this session in October, the joint project team will be hosting lunch and learn sessions September 11-13 for department leaders
- These teams will serve as the basis to support the overall change in way of work for the City







Food and Beverage Updates

- City staff will start moving into New City Hall in early 2024
- The construction of the new City Council Chamber will prevent the terrace F&B facility from opening until late 2024
- An interim F&B plan will be developed to support the transition for staff and the public







Interim Food and Beverage Options



- Daily Subscription Program:
 - Select a provider for each day of the week
 - E.g., Monday is Pizza Day, Tuesday is Taco Day, etc.
- Food Truck Program
 - Contract with different food trucks for each day of the week
- Temporary Coffee Vendor
- Enhanced Grab and Go:
 - Sandwiches, salads, re-heatables purchased from lobby location
