Reminders & Events

Fort Worth Christmas Holiday Closures

- Most City offices, including City Hall, will be closed Dec. 25 for the Christmas holiday. Emergency services will be available as usual.
 - There will be no solid waste collections (garbage, recycling, yard waste or bulk) on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Collection schedules will be temporarily adjusted from Dec. 25-Jan. 6.
 - If your normal pickup day is Monday, your pickup will be shifted to Tuesday; Tuesday collections shift to Wednesday; Wednesday collections shift to Thursday; Thursday collections shift to Friday; Friday collections shift to Saturday.
 - Bulk waste collections resume Tuesday.
 - Normal collection schedules resume Monday, Jan. 8.
 - All residents are allowed two extra bags of garbage next to the cart on their first pickup day following each holiday.
 - The City's four drop-off stations and the Environmental Collection Center will be closed Dec. 25 and reopen Dec. 26. These locations will also be closed on New Year's Day and reopen Jan. 2.
 - North Animal Campus and Chuck & Brenda Silcox Animal Care & Adoption Center will be open from noon to 6 p.m. for adoptions and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. for intakes on Dec. 24. They will be closed Dec. 25. Normal operations resume Dec. 26.
 - Both Hulen and Alliance PetSmart Adoption Centers will open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Dec. 24. They will be closed Christmas Day and open Dec. 26, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
 - All Fort Worth Public Library locations will be closed Dec. 24-25.
 - On Dec. 25, all community centers, Haws Athletic Center, FW@6 programs, Log Cabin Village and the Fort Worth Nature Center & Refuge will be closed. The water features at the Water Gardens will be turned off. All municipal golf courses will be closed Christmas Day. All municipal golf courses will be back to regular operating hours beginning, Dec. 26.
 - To access the Water Department's automated system for payments and account inquiries or to report an emergency, call the 24-hour call center at 817-392-4477.
 - On Dec. 25, Trinity Metro will operate on a modified schedule.

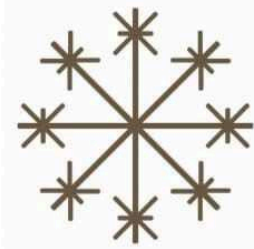
