QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18-35 YEARS OF AGE (cannot have reached 36th birthday by October 3, 2023).
- VALID and CURRENT DRIVER'S LICENSE
 - Required to obtain Class "B" driver's license after hire.
- HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, GED CERTIFICATE or 12 SEMESTER HOURS from an accredited college or university.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must live within thirty (30) minutes of a designated report-in station
 - Must be accomplished within six (6) months of employment
- Successfully pass a written test, an aerobic capacity run, a physical assessment test, a background check, a polygraph examination, an interview board and a medical / physical examination.

ADDITIONAL EXAM POINTS:

Additional five (5) points shall be added to a **passing exam** score as follows:

- **Military Veteran** = Five (5) points with Honorable Discharge, per DD214 Member 4 or Service 2
 - Must email a copy of DD214 Member 4 to <u>FWFDHiring@fortworthtexas.gov</u> no later than <u>October 2, 2023 @ 9:00 AM</u>

NOTE: The Civil Service Fire Trainee exam will be a live, in-person exam and qualified applicants will be required to report in person at their assigned location, date and time to take the exam.
