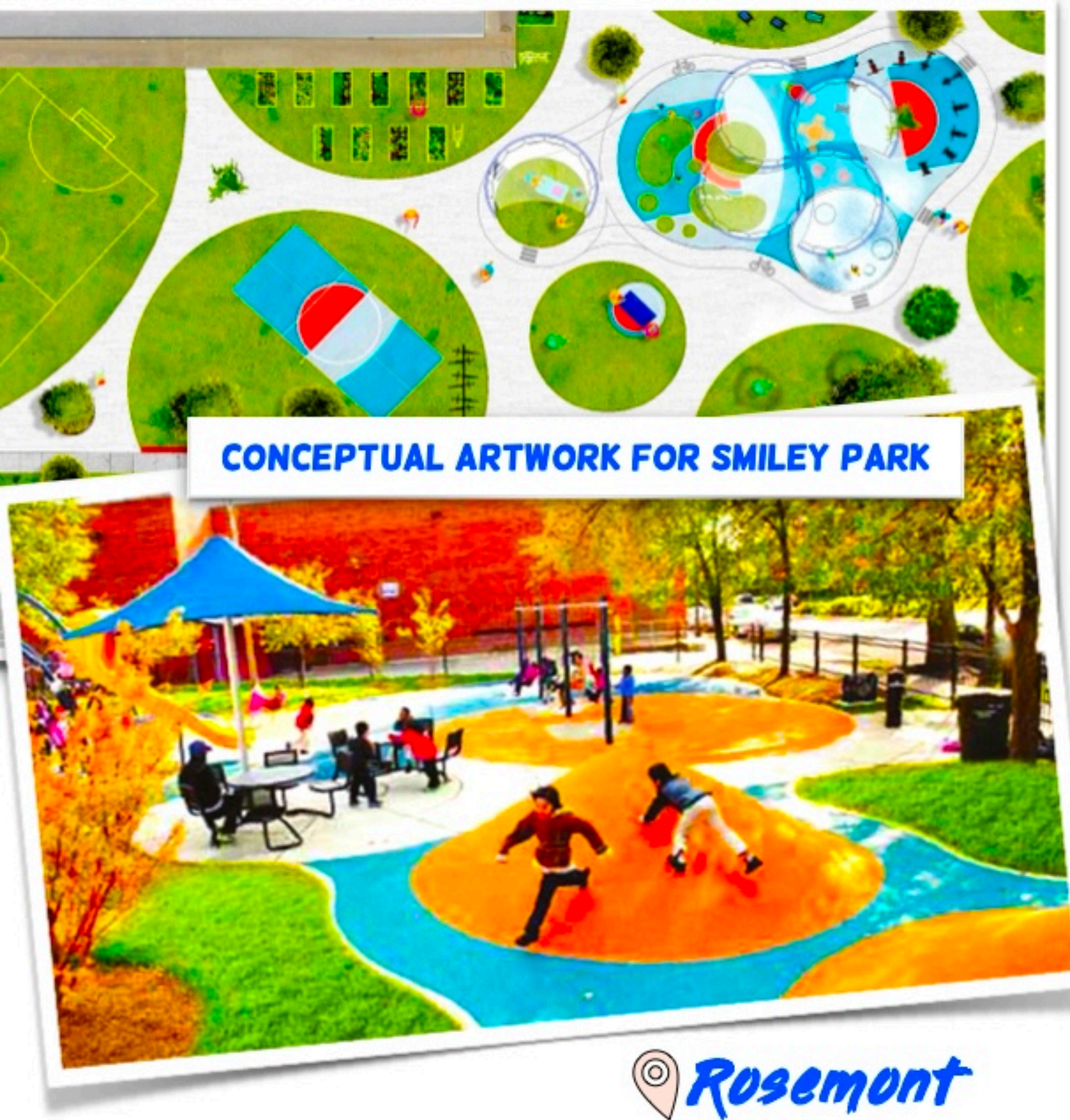

Quarterly Neighborhood Update



Launched in 2017, the Neighborhood Improvement Program has empowered residents to drive change in their community with neighborhood-focused funds



Ash Crescent

Ongoing Neighborhood Projects Include:

- Smiley Park, is a .674 acre of land at South Riverside Drive and East Maddox Avenue, donated by Dalton's Best Maid Products Inc. The park is expected to include an active zone playground featuring crawling mounds, playscape for climbing and swinging, as well as play equipment for toddlers.
- Construction is set for early 2025 with completion by December 2025.

The neighborhood selected for the 2025 Neighborhood Improvement Program will be announced in December 2024.



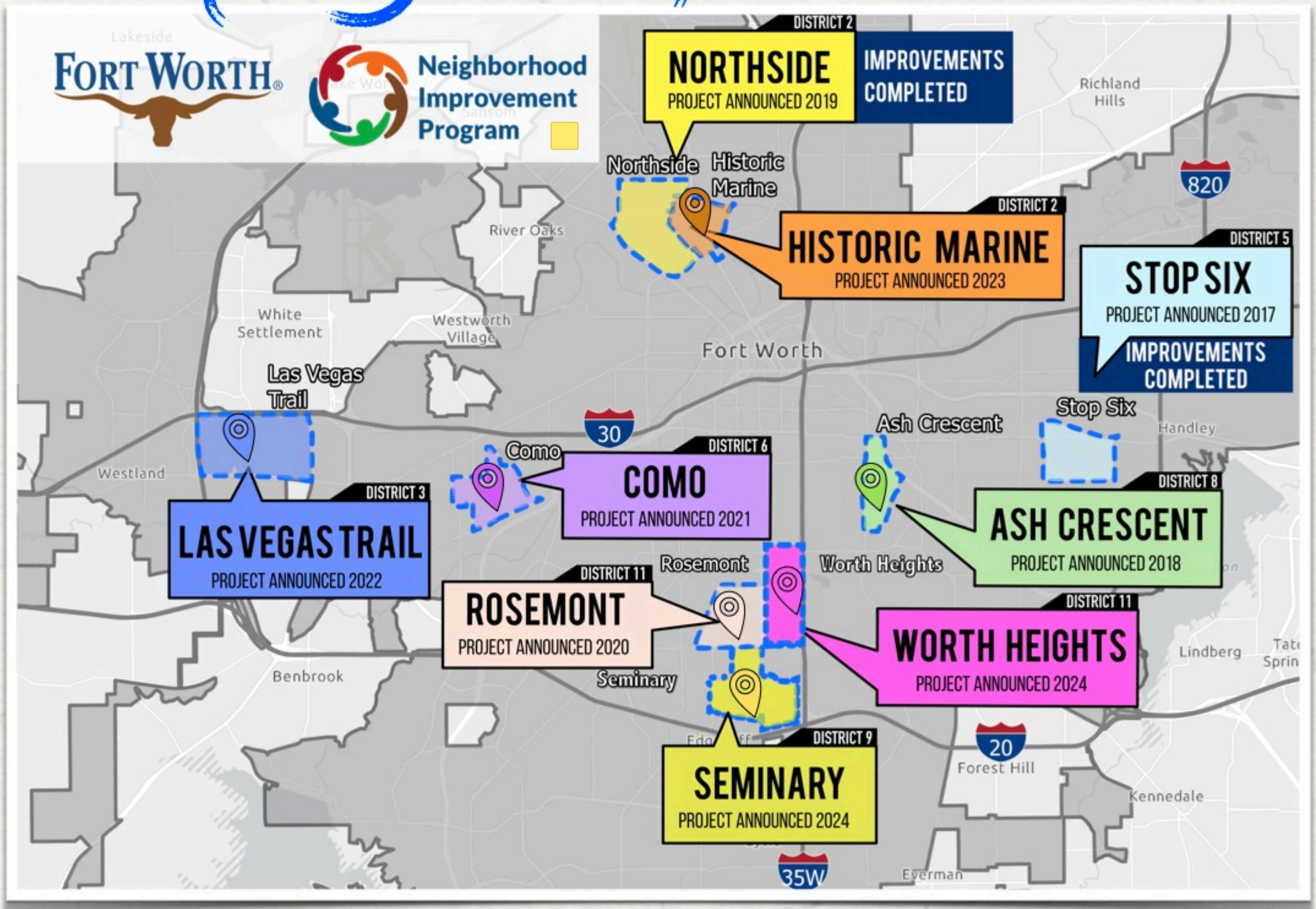
