Project Overview

A 24-inch in diameter water transmission main will be installed in northwest Fort Worth in the Northpointe area. Construction will likely impact traffic on Park Drive and Old Decatur Road as well as Park Drive at Boat Club Road. This project impacts the Northwest Fort Worth Neighborhood Alliance.

Where is this project area?

The main will start at Park Drive - just east of Boat Club Road - and extend northeasterly along the proposed extension of Heritage Trace Boulevard. Construction ends just north of the intersection of Assembly Road and North Water Tower Road, on Heritage Trace Boulevard. Lake Pointe Elementary School is east of the Centerboard Lane/Park Drive intersection at the southern end of the project area.

Why are you doing this project?

Fort Worth Water is working with Lennar Homes of Texas Land and Construction LTD to construct the 24-inch water transmission main. This main will serve the Northpointe Development and anticipated future growth in northwest Fort Worth.

What is a water transmission main?

Water transmission mains are large pipes that are 16-inches in diameter and larger. Transmission mains are designed to move large quantities of water to the smaller distribution mains and eventually to customers.

Which homes will be impacted by the construction?

North Fork Estates is an existing neighborhood near the project area. However, homes directly impacted by construction are not yet completed.

Construction of Lennar Homes Phases 1 and 2 will be concurrent with the project.

How were customers notified about this project?

Meeting mailers were sent to 263 customers. The Northwest Fort Worth Neighborhood Alliance board and council were also notified.

Will the streets leading to the construction site be impacted?

As of November 2021, the only existing homes are in North Fork Estates on the east end of the project area. Construction hours are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday-Friday and, if requested by the contractor, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m./5 p.m. on Saturdays.

What is the timeline and when will construction start?

Construction activities began in November 2021. The contractor will start construction at the southern end, just east of Park Drive at Boat Club Road. The projected end date is late summer of 2022.

How do I report an emergency or non-emergency water or sewer issue?

Emergencies

For water main breaks or sewer backups you can call 817-392-4477 – 24 hours a day - and select Option 1 to reach the Water Dispatch center.

Non-Emergencies

For non-emergencies you can reach out to our Water Call Center - at the same phone number - 817-392-4477. The Water Call Center staff answers non-emergency calls between 7 am and 7 pm, Monday-Friday. The call center is closed on City holidays.



Another option is to download the MyFW app from the App Store or Google Play.

You can report sewer overflows, leaks and water main breaks, missing or broken meter lids, water theft, water violations, no water service, water pressure issues and other sewer concerns.
