How can I pay the water and sewer tap fees?

- The plumber must first apply for a plumbing permit for each residential lot that has paid impact fees.
- Once the plumbing permit has been issued, provide the permit number to Water Applications so that fees can be invoiced.
- Water Applications will notify you that fees have been invoiced so that you can remit payment online or you may visit the office in person.
