1. <u>VA-25-002</u> <u>Vacation of a Portion of Windowmere Street and a Portion of South Edgewood Terrace: Council District 5.</u>

Being a vacation of a portion of Windowmere Street, as recorded in Volume 388, Page 51, Plat Records, Tarrant County, Texas and a portion of South Edgewood Terrace, as recorded in Volume 388-F, Page 415 and Volume 388-103, Page 826, Plat Records, Tarrant County, Texas, located in the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas.

General Location: North of East Rosedale Street, south of the Union Pacific railroad, and east of South Edgewood Terrace.
