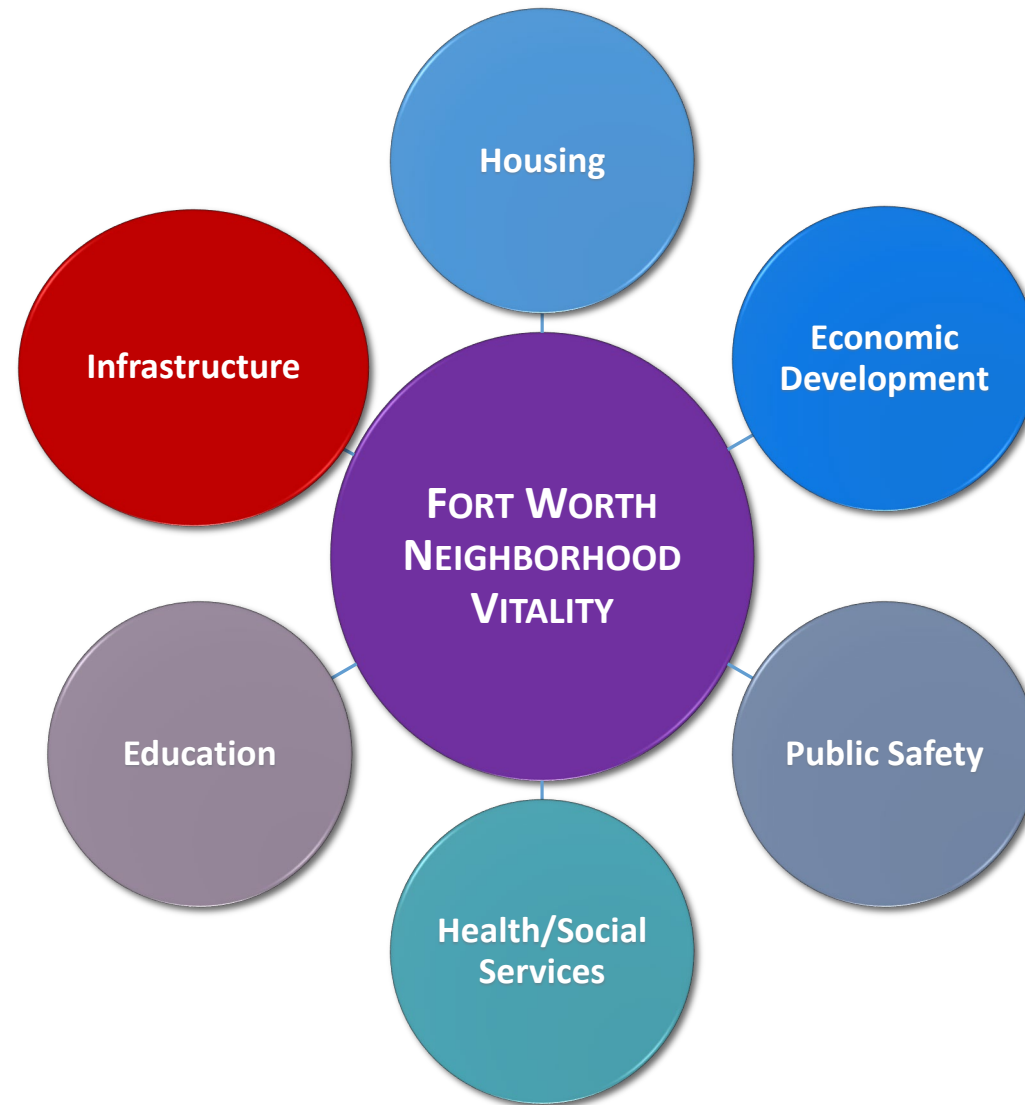

# What does neighborhood vitality look like in Fort Worth?



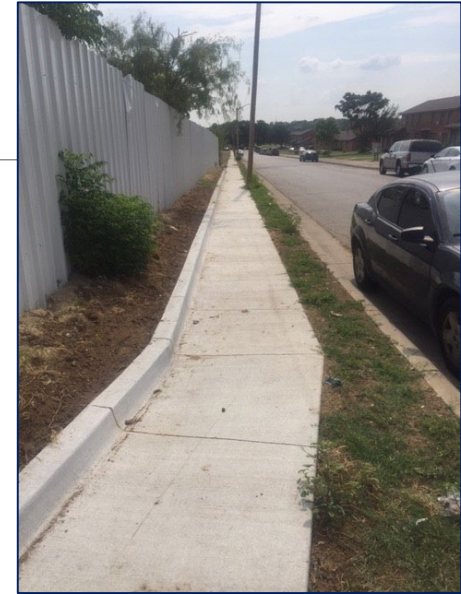
Significant **blight**
